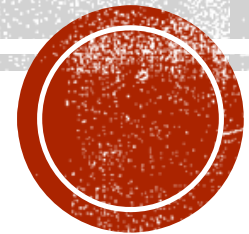

HAVE TO/ DON'T HAVE TO

▪ HAVE TO

- We use “*have to + infinitive to*” talk about rules and obligations, or to say that something is **NECESSARY**

I have to get up at 8:00 everyday

▪ DON'T HAVE TO

- We use “*don't have to + infinitive*” to say there is **NO OBLIGATION**, or something is **NOT NECESSARY**

I don't have to work on Sundays



STRUCTURE:

HAVE TO

I have to wake up at 8 everyday

You have to wake up at 8 everyday

He/she/it **has** to wake up at 8 everyday

We have to wake up at 8 everyday

You have to wake up at 8 everyday

They have to wake up at 8 everyday

DON'T HAVE TO

I don't have to wake up at 8 everyday

You I don't have to wake up at 8 everyday

He/she/it **doesn't have to** wake up at 8 everyday

We don't have to wake up at 8 everyday

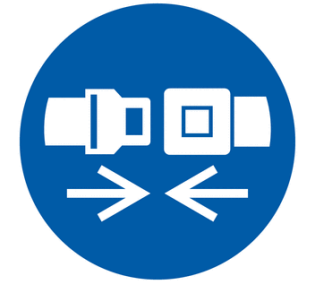
You don't have to wake up at 8 everyday

They don't have to wake up at 8 everyday



MUST / MUSTN'T

- We use “must” to express **STRONG OBLIGATION** or necessity



You must wear a seatbelt when you drive.

**You must wear
your seatbelt**

- We use “mustn’t” to say that something is **PROHIBITED**, that something is not allowed.



They mustn't take photographs here



STRUCTURE:

MUST

I must wear a seatbelt

You must wear a seatbelt

He/she/it must wear a seatbelt

We must wear a seatbelt

You must wear a seatbelt

They must wear a seatbelt

MUSTN'T

I mustn't take photographs

You mustn't take photographs

He/she/it mustn't take photographs

We mustn't take photographs

You mustn't take photographs

They mustn't take photographs
